



FACT SHEET - GARDEN MULCH

YOUR CHOICE PREMIUM COCO COIR GARDEN MULCH BLEND

What is it?

'YOUR CHOICE' Premium Coco Coir Garden Mulch is made from 100% coir (coconut fibre) from the husk of the coconut. It is a superb, long lasting ground covering used to retard weed growth, retain water and stabilise soil temperature.

Major Benefits.

- Protects plant roots from damage caused by rapid fluctuations in temperature in soils.
- Holds up to 3 times its own weight in water.
- Readily available moisture to soils and plants.
- Suppresses and reduces weeds in garden beds and around plants.
- Contains Gypsum to aid in breaking up compacted soils and allows rapid moisture and fertiliser delivery to root systems to maximise plant growth.
- NO NITROGEN DRAW DOWN.
- Keeps soils cooler in summer, minimising water evaporation.
- Doubles as a warm protective blanket in winter.
- Safe and clean.

Hints on using 'YOUR CHOICE' Premium Coco Coir Garden Mulch.

When applying 'YOUR CHOICE' Premium Coco Coir Garden Mulch to a garden bed it is ideal to keep it at a depth of 50mm to 60mm (2" to 2.5"), which means that a 50lt bag will cover an area of 1 square metre. 'YOUR CHOICE' Premium Coco Coir Garden Mulch does not lose its colour, as the top layer of mulch dries it will go a lighter colour, when water is applied it will return to its vibrant natural colour again. Does not lose its colour or decompose over time like other mulches do.

Snails and slugs do not like it; it is too absorbent for them and too coarse for them to slither over. Birds scatter the mulch less than other mulches, as there are less or no snails or slugs. Birds also find it difficult to scatter and do not see it as ideal for picking over looking for insects.

Contains 'YOUR CHOICE' Soak'N'Feed to aid in soil conditioning with added trace elements and 3 to 4 month control fertiliser.

When top layer of mulch looks dry it will not always mean you need to water. Always scratch the surface layer and check below. If it is still moist, you may not need to water.

If it's not 'YOUR CHOICE', it should be!
