



FACT SHEET - YOUR CHOICE PREMIUM COIR POTTING MIX

What is it?

100% coir (coconut fibre) made up of various grades of coir blended to create an ideal sustainable gardening growing media for all plants in all types of containers for cacti, succulents, natives, all shrubs, seedlings, small trees including all indoor and outdoor container grown plants.

'YOUR CHOICE' is also the ideal growing media for use in interior plant scaping and exterior landscaping.

Major Benefits.

- Due to the nature of the coir (coconut fibre), flowering plants tend to flower for longer periods with stronger flower stems and more intensity in colour.
- Guaranteed to grow your plants.
- Soil FREE, bark FREE and compost FREE.
- Ideal media for all types of free draining containers from terracotta, ceramic, plastic, concrete or timber planters.
- Much LESS risk of harmful bacteria and fungi than other potting mixes.

Hints for using 'YOUR CHOICE' Premium Coir Potting Mix.

When planting a new plant or re-potting an older plant in 'YOUR CHOICE' Premium Coir Potting mix, always remove all or as much as possible of the old bark mix. This will make the transition for the roots less stressful, gives them a chance to grow quicker and respond to nutrient absorption much more readily. Plants such as Daphne that have sensitive roots will respond with no transplant shock when you remove all bark mix from the root ball when planting in 'YOUR CHOICE' Premium Coir Potting Mix.

When re-potting with 'YOUR CHOICE' Premium Coir Potting Mix always fill the pot loose, do not pack down the mix as you would with traditional bark mixes. Packing down of the mix will destroy some of the high air fill porosity of the product. This prevents vital flow through of air and water. Simply tap the pot lightly and if needed top up mix after initial watering.

When top layer or surface of potting mix appears dry, stick your finger into the mix to the first or second knuckle to check moisture level before watering.
